Can you Commit?

The Camper Leadership Training program is voluntary, yet CLTs must meet the following participation requirements:

Entering Grade 8 or Above in the Fall

Commit to at least 4 Weeks

CLTs must participate in at least four 1-week sessions of camp between June 24th-August 16th.

Attend Pre-Camp Orientation

June 17-18 & 20-21

Submit required Paperwork by May 30th

Including CLT Conduct Agreement, Immunizations and a report for a Physical Exam from the last 18 months.
